The Executive Committee of the Mississippi State Board of Medical Licensure met on Wednesday, March 22, 2023, at 9:30 a.m. in the Board Room of the Office of the Board located at 1867 Crane Ridge Drive, Jackson, Mississippi. This meeting was broadcast via Zoom.

## ZOOM APPEARANCE BY DARRIN MANGIACARNE, D.O. MISSISSIPPI MEDICAL LICENSE 21086

Dr. Mangiacarne joined the meeting and was not represented by legal counsel. Dr. Mangiacarne executed a written agreement for this informal meeting, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

Dr. Mangiacarne summarized to the Executive Committee that he is the Chief Medical Officer for the corporation, Banyan Treatment Centers. Banyan Treatment Centers operate substance abuse centers in several states with contracts with Veterans Affairs and seeking to offer services to Veterans in Biloxi, MS.

Dr. Mangiacarne is seeking an exception to Rule 1.2.A., of Part 2630, Collaboration with Nurse Practitioners, regarding the 20/80 hour in-state practice requirement. Dr. Mangiacarne does not practice the minimum of twenty hours per week within state as required by the rule.

After discussion and questions from the Executive Committee, a motion was made by Dr. Owens, seconded by Dr. Lippincott, and carried that the Executive Committee enter into executive session for discussion regarding a course of action.

Upon a motion by Dr. Owens, seconded by Dr. Lippincott and carried, the Executive Committee came out of Executive Session at which time Dr. McClendon asked Dr. Lippincott to report the Executive Committee's decision. Dr. Lippincott reported that the request for an exception to rule 1.2.A of Part 2630, Collaboration is denied. Dr. Mangiacarne is encouraged to provide these services through the usual regulatory process.

## ZOOM APPEARANCE BY ALLA ADI SHABTAI, P.A. APPLICANT

Ms. Shabtai joined the meeting and was not represented by legal counsel. Ms. Shabtai executed a written agreement for this informal meeting, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

Ms. Shabtai advised she had received a formal letter of denial for licensure due to not meeting the requirement for a master's degree in a health related or science field as stipulated in Miss. Code Ann. § 73-26-3(4) and is requesting an exception.

After discussion, a motion is made by Dr. Owens, seconded by Dr. Lippincott, and carried to uphold the denial because to Ms. Shabtai does not meet the statutory requirements for a permanent physician assistant license.

## PERSONAL APPEARANCE BY GOPINATH PERUMAL, M.D. APPLICANT

Dr. Perumal joined the meeting and was not represented by legal counsel. Dr. Perumal was accompanied by Christopher D. Anderson, M.D., James D. Hardy Professor, Chairman, UMMC Department of Surgery and Phillip Burch, M.D., UMMC, Children's of Mississippi Hospital, Chief of Congenital heart Surgery. Dr. Perumal executed a written agreement for this informal meeting, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

Dr. Perumal briefly summarized his request seeking a permanent medical license and an exception to Part 2605, Chapter 1, Rule 1.1.D, Licensure by Credentials, of the Board's Administrative Code. Dr. Perumal is an international medical school graduate who has not completed three years of ACGME postgraduate training and is not currently board certified.

After discussion and questions from the Executive Committee, a motion was made by Dr. Owens, seconded by Dr. Lippincott, and carried that the Executive Committee enter into executive session for discussion regarding a course of action.

Upon a motion by Dr. Owens, seconded by Dr. Lippincott and carried, the Executive Committee came out of Executive Session at which time Dr. McClendon asked Dr. Lippincott

to report the Executive Committee's decision. Dr. Lippincott reported that the request for an exception to the rule was granted, and Dr. Perumal shall be issued a limited institutional license.

#### ZOOM APPEARANCE BY MICHELLE BOYER, PA-C APPLICANT

Ms. Boyer joined the meeting and was not represented by legal counsel. Ms. Boyer executed a written agreement for this informal meeting, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

Ms. Boyer briefly summarized her request for an exception to the requirement of a master's degree as stipulated in Miss. Code Ann. § 73-26-3(4) and advised that she had not completed her master's degree.

Ms. Boyer was advised by the Board Attorney that the master's degree was a statutory requirement and there is not an exception to this requirement. There is a statutory exception that could potentially apply only if the applicant has established themselves as a Mississippi resident. If so, they may qualify for a Mississippi license under the license portability rules that are in effect for physician assistants.

After discussion, a motion is made by Dr. Lippincott, seconded by Dr. Owens, and carried to uphold the denial due to Ms. Boyer does not meet the statutory requirements for a permanent physician assistant license.


